



APPENDIX F-1: SCOPE OF SERVICES:

Adult Day Care Services

Service Definition
Adult Day Care Services are the provision of services for part of a day in a nonresidential group setting to adults who need an enriched social or health supportive experience or who need assistance with activities of daily living, supervision, and/or protection. Services may include; personal care and supervision, light meals, medical care, and transportation to and from the Adult Day Care center site. Transportation between the member's place of residence and the Adult Day Care center may be provided as a component of adult day care services. The cost of this transportation is included in the rate paid to providers of adult day care services. Meals provided as part of Adult Day Care may not constitute a "full nutritional regimen" (3 meals per day).
Provider Qualifications
Adult Day Care centers must be certified by the Department, under Wis. Stat. § 49.45(2)(a)(11), to provide adult day care services. *Providers of this service are subject to the requirements as stated, and by execution of this contract attest to meeting the Provider Qualifications as listed above.
Applicable Service Limitations
This service may not duplicate any service that is provided under another waiver service category or through the Medicaid State Plan.
