



APPENDIX F-1: SCOPE OF SERVICES:

Home Delivered Meals

Service Definition
Home Delivered Meals are meals provided to recipients who are unable to prepare or obtain nourishing meals without assistance, including those who may be unable to manage a special diet recommended by their physician. Home-delivered meal costs may include the costs associated with the purchase and planning of food, nutrition services, supplies, equipment, labor, and transportation to deliver one or two meals a day.
Provider Qualifications
• Hospitals and nursing homes must comply with Wis. Admin. Code Ch. DHS 124, DHS 132, and DHS 134. • Aging network agencies must comply with Wis. Stat. § 46.82(3). • Restaurants must comply with Wis. Admin. Code Ch. ATPCP 75.
Applicable Service Limitations
• This service may not duplicate any service that is provided under another waiver service category or through the Medicaid State Plan. • Home delivered meals may not constitute a "full nutritional regimen" (3 meals per day). • This service does not include payment for meals at federally subsidized nutrition sites. • Meals must align with USDA Dietary Guidelines for Americans standards, be medically appropriate for the member, and must provide a minimum of one-third of the estimated daily calorie needs for the member's age group
