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| <p><b>Transportation (Specialized Transportation) – Community Transportation</b> is the provision of transportation services or items that enable a member to engage with the community, including with the people, places and resources that are meaningful for the member's self-determination and that meet their goals and daily needs. This service allows the member to gain access to waiver services, a place of employment, and other community services, activities and resources, as specified in the member's care plan. This service may consist of items such as tickets, fare cards or other fare media, or services where the common carrier, transportation network company driver, specialized medical vehicle, or other provider directly conveys a member and the member's attendant, if any, to destinations. Whenever possible, family, neighbors, friends or community agencies who can provide this service without charge will be utilized.</p> |
